

Ballot Instructions

Attached to the bottom of these instructions is a ballot for voting in the ratification referendum of the tentative BLET-Amtrak Agreement in accordance with Section 41(a)—General Committee Rules of the BLET Bylaws.

1. If you are holding an official position on the railroad you are NOT entitled to vote.
2. If you do not hold seniority as an Amtrak Passenger Engineer, Student Engineer or Engine Attendant you are NOT entitled to vote.
3. Retired Members are NOT entitled to vote.
4. If you belong to the BLET and your name appears on the current Amtrak Passenger Engineer's National Seniority Roster or the Engine Attendant Roster you ARE entitled to vote.
5. If you or someone you know did not receive a ballot and you believe you are entitled to vote, please call the office of the National Secretary-Treasurer at (216) 241-2630, ext. 227 and request a replacement ballot.
6. Mark your choice with an "X" in the appropriate box either "In Favor" of the tentative agreement or "Against" the tentative agreement. DO NOT SIGN THE BALLOT, WRITE ANYTHING ELSE OR DEFACE IT IN ANY WAY.
7. Cut the marked ballot at the dotted line and insert in the enclosed postage paid return envelope. Clearly print your name, address and Local Division number in the upper left hand corner of the return envelope.
8. Your ballot must be received in the office of the NST no later than March 28, 2008 in order to be counted.

(Mark the ballot, separate along the dotted line, and place in the enclosed business reply envelope)
